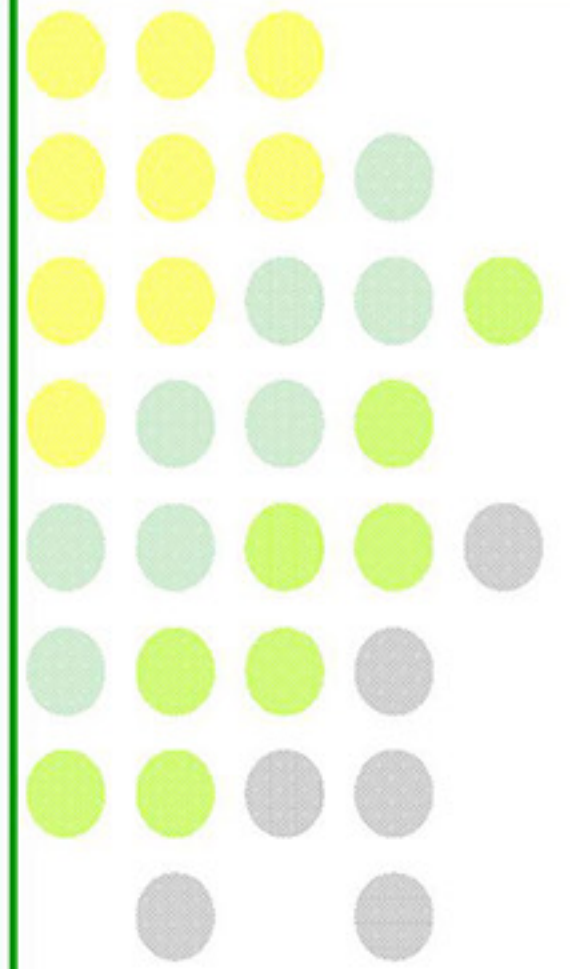




# Ancestral Halls: What Max Weber Never Knew
